

Thank you for renting your bounce house from BreMar Rental.

Attached are some tips for a better rental.

- Pick a flat surface no more then 50' from an outlet. We can provide a 10 gauge extension cord to protect the blower. Please do not use any other cords as they can damage the blower.
- Lay a tarp down on the grass to protect the bottom on the bouncer and make sure you stake the inflatable down with the included stakes. This will prevent the bouncer from moving and causing injury. Periodically check that the stakes are still firmly in the ground over the course of the rental.
- Attach the blower to the back of the bounce house by putting the sleeve of the bounce house over the lip of the blower. Secure it with the attached tie down.
- To prevent lost shoes and grass in the bounce house we recommend a laundry basket be kept by the entrance to collect shoes and a small rug for kids to use when going in and out.
- In the event of high winds (gusts over 20mph) deflate the bounce house and secure it from damage. If it rains deflate the bounce house, remove the blower from the back of the unit and bring it indoors. Then fold the bouncer in thirds like a burrito and put the tarp over it. Secure the corners of the tarp with something heavy like stones to prevent the tarp from blowing off the bouncer. We charge a minimum of \$75 if you return the unit wet, or if the unit is wet upon pick up if you requested delivery.
- Once the rain has passed you may re-inflate the bounce house.
- The cleaning deposit will be refunded when the bounce house comes back clean, dry and without kids!!
